Grade Level 2020-2021	Required Book/Novel	Author	Suggested Summer Literacy Activity
Kindergarten	The Kissing Hand	Audrey Penn	Read and discuss the book with a family member. Draw a picture of your favorite part of the story. Please bring your drawing with you on the first day of school. Or complete Weekly Reading Log- Weekly Reading Log
First Grade	Flat Stanley (Any one in series)	Jeff Brown	Draw a picture of your favorite page. Explain in writing why this is your favorite page. Or complete Weekly Reading Log- Weekly Reading Log
Second Grade	My Weirdest School (Any one in series)	Dan Gutman	Create a picture timeline of 5-10 events/facts in the book. Write and label each of the events to provide facts, definitions, or important details. Or complete Weekly Reading Log- Weekly Reading Log
Third Grade	A to Z Mysteries (any one in series)	Ron Roy	Create a "Top Ten List" about important events, characters, and ideas in the book. Your "Top Ten List" should be written and illustrated. Or complete Weekly Reading Log- Weekly Reading Log
Fourth Grade	Because of Winn Dixie	Kate Dicamillo	Create a collage with words and pictures around themes or characters in the book. Write a brief summary on back of collage of the story. Or complete Weekly Reading Log- Weekly Reading Log
Fifth Grade	Scat	Carl Hiaasen	Create a poster that is a book cover/jacket for the novel. The front cover should include the title and author along with an illustration of the story. The remainder of the book cover/jacket poster should include elaborative and colorful details about the book, with a focus on literary elements such as conflict, mood, setting, theme, plot, rising action, climax, falling action, resolution, point of view, and characterization. Or complete Weekly Reading Log- Weekly Reading Log

Log In: Use your ID number for both username and password

There are 3 ways to see available e-books:

1-VIEW BY RESOURCE LISTS: Click on the “CATALOG” tab, then click on “Resource Lists” (on the left vertical tabs)

Resource lists have two e-book lists: one is for reading levels/grades K-5, and the other is for middle school grades 6-8. You shall see 500 titles from K-5th grade reading level & 127 e-books for middle school reading levels.

2-VIEW BY READING LEVEL: In the box to NARROW YOUR SEARCH, use the drop down menu for MATERIAL TYPE to click on “electronic books”. Use the drop down menu for READING PROGRAM to open area for reading level to be entered. Fill in required information and it will reveal which of the e-books we own that are on AR. Then click ENTER, and you shall see 500 titles from K-5th grade reading level and 127 e-books for middle school reading levels.

3-VIEW FOLLETT SHELF: found by clicking on CATALOG tab and on the left side of vertical tabs, click on FOLLETT SHELF. Do a search.
