Grade Level 2020-2021 School Year	Required Book/Novel	Author	Suggested Summer Literacy Activity
Sixth Grade	Flush	Carl Hiassen	Create a TOP Ten List in which you write and illustrate events or ideas you learned from the book. Or Complete District Reading Log (at least 10 entries) Vocabulary Reading Log
Seventh Grade	Flipped	Wendelin Van Draanen	Write a letter of advice (one page, of at least 200 words) to one of the characters about how to solve his or her problem. Be sure to incorporate specific examples from the novel. Students may write or type the letter (do not bring an envelope). You do not have to buy the book or have it in class. You may check it out from the library, if it's available. Or Complete District Reading Log (at least 10 entries) Vocabulary Reading Log
Eighth Grade	Chomp	Carl Hiassen	Create a timeline of the major events in the book. Use drawings or magazine cutouts to show the events along the timeline. Label each event. Or Complete District Reading Log (at least 10 entries) Vocabulary Reading Log

Log In: Use your ID number for both username and password

There are 3 ways to see available e-books:

1-VIEW BY RESOURCE LISTS: Click on the “CATALOG” tab, then click on “Resource Lists” (on the left vertical tabs)

Resource lists have two e-book lists: one is for reading levels/grades K-5, and the other is for middle school grades 6-8. You shall see 500 titles from K-5th grade reading level & 127 e-books for middle school reading levels.

2-VIEW BY READING LEVEL: In the box to NARROW YOUR SEARCH, use the drop down menu for MATERIAL TYPE to click on “electronic books”. Use the drop down menu for READING PROGRAM to open area for reading level to be entered. Fill in required information and it will reveal which of the e-books we own that are on AR. Then click ENTER, and you shall see 500 titles from K-5th grade reading level and 127 e-books for middle school reading levels.

3-VIEW FOLLETT SHELF: found by clicking on CATALOG tab and on the left side of vertical tabs, click on FOLLETT SHELF. Do a search.
